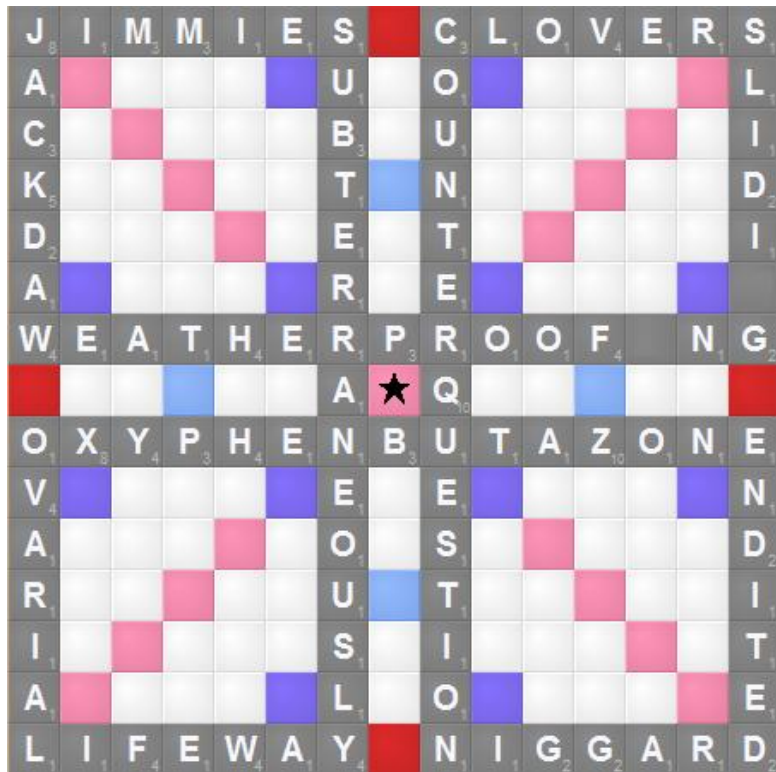


# SCRABLEAUX

A tableau or a “scrableau” is a quick way to confirm you have all 100 tiles in the correct frequency before and after a game. You can arrange your tiles in four 5x5 squares in each corner of the board to confirm there are 100, but if you want to make sure you have the correct number of each tile, you can construct one of these scrableaux. In the table below, a question mark represents a blank tile.
